10 DAY TASTE OF TURKEY TOUR WITH 2 NIGHTS ON A GULET Istanbul – Marmaris

DEPARTS ISTANBUL THURSDAYS

15 APRIL - 28 OCTOBER 2021

Tour is guaranteed to operate with a minimum of 2 and a maximum 32 passengers.

Day 1 (Thursday) ARRIVE ISTANBUL

Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the hotel. A welcome briefing will be held this evening.

Day 2 (Friday) ISTANBUL

Enjoy a full day tour including a visit to Topkapi Palace, residence of the Ottoman Sultans 1453 – 1852 (excluding harem). Visit the Hippodrome, which was once the centre of life where chariot racing and other public events took place. Tour the Blue Mosque, built between 1609 and 1616, famous for its blue ceramic tiles. Next see St. Sophia, a church built in the 6th century Byzantine capital, converted to a mosque by the Ottomans, and now a museum and one of the world's greatest architectural wonders. Your last stop will be the famous Grand Bazaar, the world's largest and oldest covered market with over 60 streets. (B) Evening optional: Dinner with belly dancing entertainment



Day 3 (Saturday) ISTANBUL / GALLIPOLI / CANAKKALE

In the morning depart for Gallipoli. Visit Anzac Cove, Lone Pine Cemetery and Chunuk Bair, and then cross the Dardanelles to Canakkale for overnight. (B,D)

Day 4 (Sunday) CANNAKALE / TROY / PERGAMON / IZMIR

Visit Troy with its famous wooden horse, best known for being the setting of the Trojan War and many cities built on top of each other. Before arriving at the Asclepion enjoy lunch with locals in a traditional village. Then continue to Pergamum to visit the ancient Asclepion Medical Centre and continue to Izmir for overnight. (B) Evening optional: Dinner at local restaurant

Day 5 (Monday) IZMIR / EPHESUS & VIRGIN MARY'S HOUSE / IZMIR

Tour the famous ruins of Ephesus, an important cultural centre of the ancient world, and explore 2,000 year-old marble streets, a theatre, the Library of Celsus, a gymnasium and Hadrian's Temple. Take a short drive to see the stone cottage where it is believed Virgin Mary spent her last years accompanied by St. John. Continue to a regional rug production centre to have a firsthand experience of this unique art form. (B,D)

Day 6 (Tuesday) IZMIR / BODRUM

After breakfast drive to Bodrum to visit the castle of St. Peter and the renowned Underwater Museum that was awarded the best Underwater Museum of the World in 2000's. Overnight in Bodrum. (B,D)

Day 7 (Wednesday) BODRUM / GOCEK OR FETHIYE

After breakfast drive to the resort city of Gocek or Fethiye to board a gulet yacht. (B,D)

Day 8 (Thursday) GULET CRUISE (LYCIAN COAST)

Sail across beautiful bays surrounded by high-forested hills. (B,L,D)









Day 9 (Friday) GULET CRUISE (LYCIAN COAST)

Continue cruising the Mediterranean coast, explore nearby Lycian ruins, swim or simply relax. (B,L,D)

Day 10 (Saturday) GULET CRUISE (LYCIAN COAST) / MARMARIS

Your cruise ends with breakfast in Marmaris. Transfer to port or hotel in Marmaris. (B)
